2027 JNA REPRESENTATIVE PROGRAM

A New Approach to Development & Selection

The 2027 JNA Representative Program will look a little different as we strengthen our pathway for players, coaches and families.

Our focus is to provide a clear, transparent and development focused program built around commitment, teamwork, accountability and performance.

Squad Selection

For 2027, players will initially trial for selection into a Representative Squad, rather than a final team.

Squad selection provides players with an extended development and assessment period and does not guarantee final team selection.

Throughout this period, coaches and selectors will consider:

Where numbers allow for multiple teams but only one meets the required standard, JNA may nominate a single team.

STEPPING Rule

Netball Australia's stepping rule (or footwork) dictates that once a player catches the ball, the landing foot must remain grounded while they move the other foot, or pivot. Dragging, sliding, or hopping on the landing foot is prohibited. Lifting the landing foot requires the ball to be released before it regrounds.

Key Aspects of the Footwork Rule:

- One-Foot Landing: The first foot to touch the ground after catching the ball is the "landing foot". You can move the other foot freely.
- Two-Foot Landing: If landing on both feet simultaneously, either foot can be the landing foot, but moving both is a violation.
- Pivoting: A player can pivot on the spot using the landing foot.
- Moving the Landing Foot: Once the landing foot is lifted to step, it cannot be grounded again before the ball is thrown or shot.
- Infringement: Stepping results in a free pass to the opposing team.

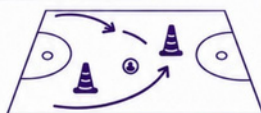

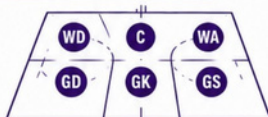
